

## **AWNMAX**

### **8 YEAR WARRANTY**

WESTERN RIM INDUSTRIES LTD. warrants to its customers that AWNMAX fabric, to be sold by WESTERN RIM INDUSTRIES LTD., To be used as a component for illuminated awnings or signs, will remain in good and acceptable condition for at least eight (8) years when fabricated, installed and maintained according to instructions. The warranty covers excessive loss of color, and/or loss of strength from normal exposure to the extent that the fabric becomes ineffective for its intended use when viewed at a normal viewing distance, subject to the following provisions:

If during the first three (3) years of normal use from the date of installation, AWNMAX should exhibit excessive loss of color or strength, WESTERN RIM INDUSTRIES LTD. will furnish new AWNMAX to the original fabricator in exchange for the original fabric.

If there is excessive loss of color or strength after the first three (3) years, but before the end of eight (8) years, WESTERN RIM INDUSTRIES LTD. will grant an allowance equal to 1/96th of the purchase price of the original fabric for each month remaining in the initial eight (8) year period. This allowance may be towards the purchase of new AWNMAX or it can be in the form of a credit.

The warranty on color loss is subject to the following exceptions:

Color loss after the first five (5) years will be judged by appearance of the vertical portions of the awning or sign.

Because of the high temperatures and UV exposure encountered in the Southwest desert areas of the United States, AWNMAX will be warrantied for excessive color loss for five (5) years in these desert areas.

The foregoing is not applicable to awnings/signs damaged due to roof run-off or other harmful chemicals nor to awnings/signs which have been neglected and not maintained nor cleaned regularly according to maintenance instructions. The warranty is also void if damage is a direct/indirect result of improper use, vandalism or acts of God.

WESTERN RIM INDUSTRIES LTD. warranty extends only to the replacement or allowance as stated and does not extend to any indirect or consequential expenses or losses such as labor, installation, decorations, etc.

All claims must be presented in writing accompanied by the original invoice and work order as well as high quality photograph reproduction of the section of awning deemed defective. This must be done within a period of thirty (30) days from the complaint.

AWNMAX is compatible with 3M high performance translucent films. Please refer to AWNMAX SPECIFICATIONS & PERFORMANCE STANDARDS listed on reverse side for additional information.
